Three years ago, Stuart Montaldo created a board game called "Cognito: The Alien Adventure Game" that helped spur children's interest in space and science. Since then, he has developed two more games in the Cognito series. His latest game is Codebreaker, based on an old favorite — the Memory pair-matching game. Codebreaker has won seven national awards, including being named one of the 10 Best Games for 2006 by Dr. Toy.
